#MeToo, domestic abuse and pay gap – Über die Benachteiligung und Misshandlung von Frauen diskutieren

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Als Reaktion auf Sarah Everards Schicksal (März 2021) protestieren Frauen weltweit gegen Gewalt an Frauen. Der Hashtag #MeToo wurde im Zusammenhang mit dem Skandal um Harvey Weinstein im Oktober 2017 und Jeffrey Epstein (von 2008–2019) besonders häufig in den sozialen Netzwerken benutzt und gibt Zeugnis von Frauen, die sexuelle Belästigung und Gewalt erfahren haben. Diese und weitere Geschehnisse werden in den vorliegenden Unterrichtsmaterialien mithilfe von Textauszügen, Videos und Podcasts diskutiert und beurteilt.


