By using the tool *Quizlet*, students enhance their **lexical skills**. They learn and practise **thematic vocabulary** in different forms and receive **immediate feedback** online. Students can play the term as an audio and thus train their **listening and speaking abilities**. Furthermore, students enhance their **media competences** by using the online tool.

Notes on the material

Quizlet is a browser-based tool that enables teachers to provide relevant vocabulary for a text, a video or a certain topic for their students. The tool offers various ways of learning and practising the vocabulary and generating vocabulary quizzes that can be either carried out online or printed out. Teachers need to register on <https://quizlet.com/de> with their email address and a password. Students do not need an account.



Teachers can create a “Lernset” either by typing in the vocabulary or importing a vocabulary list from *Microsoft Word* or *Microsoft Excel* (click on “+ aus Word, Excel, Google Docs usw. importieren” follow the tips and description). *Quizlet* also offers pictures that fit the term to illustrate new vocabulary. When finished, teachers can share the “Lernset” with their students. If students have a *Quizlet* account, teachers can share the “Lernset” via link or email (click on “teilen”). If students do not have an account, teachers should share the “Lernset” via the embed link (click on the three dots → “Einbetten” → choose the “Lernmodus” → copy only the link, not the whole iframe). Students can then practise the vocabulary in the corresponding “Lernmodus”.
