Figurencharakterisierung in der Serie "Boy Swallows Universe" – Creating a film podcast

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Basierend auf dem fachdidaktischen Fundament der "Komplexen Kompetenzaufgabe" nach Wolfgang Hallet, gestalten Ihre Schülerinnen und Schüler eine eigene Podcast-Folge für einen fiktiven Schülerpodcast, der die Serien- und Filmpräferenzen junger Leute thematisiert. Die Lernenden analysieren die Literaturverfilmung des gleichnamigen Romans "Boy Swallows Universe" von Trent Dalton und gestalten eine Podcast-Folge, in der sie sich über die Figuren der Miniserie austauschen und dabei ihre eigenen Seherwartungen und -erfahrungen reflektieren.

Let's talk podcast! – What is it and how do you like it?



Your class has been chosen to create a film podcast! What do you know about podcasts?

Tasks

- Imagine the following situation: Your class has been chosen to participate in creating an
 episode for a film podcast. To prepare for your podcast, take notes on the tasks a)—c):
 - a) List podcasts you know and/or listen to.
 - b) Describe why you like / do not like listening to them.
 - c) Compare your lists and outline similarities and differences between the podcasts that you listen to.
- 2. Read the info box on podcasts.
 - a) Describe the picture. Speculate as to how podcasts have an impact on people's lives.
 - b) Summarise the functions of podcasts mentioned.
 - Speculate what topics, hosts and quests a film podcast might include.

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Info box: Podcasts



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A podcast is a digital medium that usually consists of various audio episodes addressing a specific topic or theme. There is a wide array of podcast hosts from the worlds of science, entertainment, sport, business, politics, and health who produce audio content that is then presented to their audiences in an entertaining, educational, or even opinion-shaping manner. Podcasts may inform about a topic, raise awareness about or document cultural and nistoric events. They are also widely used by companies as a means of marketing to promote

a brand and to market products and services. The mode of representation varies from personal to scientific or humorous discussions of topics. Some podcast shows are known for their host giving a talk, sometimes referring to posts or comments of listeners or hosts engaging in a conversation with expert guests or even shows that have various hosts that all contribute to a topic. The content created is distributed via podcasters' websites, radio stations or networks or is available through streaming services such as YouTube, Spotify, Apple Podcasts or Amazon Music and Audible or radio channels. While most podcasts are free of charge, some require payment or subscription. Often, new podcast episodes are released regularly on a daily, weekly or monthly basis. According to information provided by Spotify (2025), some of the most popular podcast shows on their platform are "The Joe Rogan Experience", "Call her Daddy" and "Huberman Lab".

 - c) Choose at least two of the quotations from the series and try to match them with the characters depicted in the film poster. Put them in a possible context.

 - a) Take notes on what you learn about the characters, topics, genre and plot.
 - In your team, discuss which of your expectations have been met. Also, talk about which of the quotations you heard in the trailer and in what context.
 - c) Write a short text and explain if you expect to enjoy watching the show or if you are sceptical. Also, elaborate on your watching habits.
